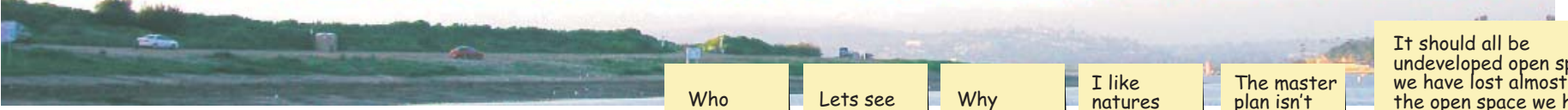


FIESTA ISLAND GENERAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN

The Top Ten Big Questions for Fiesta Island

1) How much of the island should remain as undeveloped open space, and how much of it should be turned into more intensive parkland?

- All of it. (6 times)
- Define open space, off limits: NO
- Define more intensive.
- No intensive parkland
- Develop as little as possible
- Develop as little as possible
- Remain as undeveloped space

2) Should the roadways be pulled away from the bay edge to handle more turfed parkland with organized parking lots (similar to the east side of Mission Bay) or should it remain as a road, with a pull-off edge for parking and beachside use? Or a combination of both?

- Leave parking as is. There is no reason to change
- There is enough parking
- Better shuttles during OTL
- No parking lots

3) Should the "Over the Line" sand area be relocated closer to the entrance of the island (to allow more walk-on, less wind and dust) or should it stay where it is?

- Move
- Stay where it is. (6 times)

4) Should the sand maintenance area be allowed to remain on the island or should it be moved off the island?

- Leave it on the island

5) What parts of the island should leash-free dog use be allowed?

- Large fenced area like current area as well as at least some isolated areas for less dog friendly dogs.
- None of it dogs can go anywhere. Native plants & animals cannot
- All of it (5 times)

- The whole island leash free
- All of it currently used. Don't make dog area smaller

6) Should the small and scattered plant species (previously unknown) at the south and central portions of the island be preserved where they are or should this area be used for park purposes and mitigated through establishing new sensitive plant habitats at the north end of the island?

- Not native park preserve. Active park
- You cannot recreate nature. Those small little islands of native plants need to be preserved as is or they will die out. We should expand these small areas.
- Preserve the plants
- Leave them
- Leave the plants alone-if they can grow in garbage they deserve to live
- Dogs gotta run fish gotta swim birds gotta fly plants gotta grow
- I have approx. 5,000 Torrey Pine Trees I would like to see planted on this island.

7) The adopted master plan shows a two-way street around most of the island. Is a two-way preferred or should a one-way be kept as it currently is? If it can be shown to be safer for cyclists, walkers and runners, would changing the direction (counter clockwise to clockwise) of the flow of one-way traffic be acceptable?

- One-way: No intersections, stopping for cycling
- One way CCW is stupid and requires a crossover
- Changing direction is safer. No two-way

9) Should the north end of the island have the outer loop road removed with a new multi-use trail added back, or should the road remain and be used like a trail and have vehicular use limited to different times of the day, week or season?

10) Should the west side of the island be dredged to make a larger beach area and bay turning area or should it stay the same?
